BOOK REPORT ASSIGNMENT - NOVEMBER

Due Date: November

Assignment: Select a *HISTORICAL FICTION* book that interests you and have the book approved by your teacher.

Assignment Description:

Invent a Cereal based on the historical fiction book that you read.

Save an empty cereal box and cover it with light colored paper.

- ✓ Choose a cereal name that sounds exciting and relates to the story.
- ✓ Choose colors and ingredients that relate to the story.

Draw a sketch of your cereal box on draft paper as follows:

- ✓ FRONT OF BOX: Cereal name and an appropriate illustration that includes characters or scenes that may help sell your product. Look at other cereal boxes for ideas. Make your cereal box appealing and fun.
- ✓ BACK OF BOX: Design a game that is based on the historical story you read. Suggestions: puzzle, word game, maze, or other fun activity.
- ✓ RIGHT SIDE OF BOX: Under the heading 'Ingredients', list the main story's characters and write a sentence about each one. Then, describe the setting (place and time).
- ✓ LEFT SIDE OF BOX: Write a summary of the book you read. Then, describe the main conflict and the resolution.
- ✓ TOP OF BOX: Write the book's title, author, and your name.

Draw the final design and book summaries from the sketch/draft on each side on your cereal box.

Presentation: Plan a two-minute commercial for your cereal and present it to the class.
